



CODE OF CONDUCT

All Sherpa Consulting personnel have an obligation to improve the standing of their profession by observing the Code of Conduct for their professional association or institution. In addition, Sherpa personnel agree to the following:

1. To act professionally, accurately and in an unbiased manner.
2. To strive to increase the competence and prestige of their profession.
3. To assist those under their supervision in developing their management, professional and technical skills.
4. To disclose to any Client any relationship that may be seen as a conflict of interest and that may influence their judgement.
5. Not to discuss or disclose any information relating to a project unless required by law or authorised in writing by the Client.
6. Not to offer or accept any inducement, commission, gift or any other benefit (apart from fair payment) from Client organisations, their employees or any interested party, or knowingly allow colleagues to do so.
7. Not to intentionally communicate false or misleading information that may compromise the integrity of any study.
8. Not to act in any way that would prejudice the reputation of Sherpa.
